Thematic focus of the two-day conference is on recent issues in (Public) International Law in three different countries – Australia, China and Germany. All panels consist of speakers from the three partner universities. The conference aims at highlighting current issues regarding Public International Law from three different perspectives and at discussing similarities, as well as differences in, and approaches to problems in the respective legal setting. The conference is embedded in the well-established Trilateral Strategic Network MQ-FU-HAM between Macquarie University in Sydney, Australia, Fudan University in Shanghai, China and Universität Hamburg, Germany. The Trilateral Partnership has been launched in 2013 and accounts for an example of successful strategic networking. Since its establishment, 21 sub projects have been developed and are partly funded within the DAAD funding program “Strategic Partnerships and Thematic Networks”.
