### **Initial situation**

Having a good idea is one thing - convincing people of it is quite another. You need to make a convincing case so that your idea gets the support it deserves.

### **Objective**

In the basic course “The art of persuasive argumentation” you will test your argumentative skills in the supreme discipline of rhetoric: the debate. Can your arguments withstand the attacks of the other side? Can you show why your points are more relevant than others? Can you convince the audience of your idea? With short theoretical inputs and lots of practical exercises, you will expand your argumentative skills. Learn to be even more convincing than before - and, of course, to be more convincing than the other side!
